

Racing NSW policy – Jockey/Trainer dual licence

1 June 2016

Racing NSW issues licences to Trainers or separately to Jockeys, but does not have a category allowing one to be also licensed as the other (dual licence).

Racing NSW policy – Jockey/Trainer licence – visiting from another jurisdiction

Racing NSW notes that some racing jurisdictions have a category Jockey/Trainer (dual licence).

Racing NSW policy when these licencees make application to race in NSW is:

- Dual licence holders visiting NSW - Jockey/Trainer - are permitted (subject to the usual licensing requirements) to start horses/operate in NSW as a Trainer, but not be licensed as a Jockey, Apprentice Jockey or Approved Rider.
